





Ramadan Food Pack Distribution




Qurbani Meat Distribution



Supplementary Food Packs



Ramadan is the holiest month in the Islamic calendar, observed by Muslims worldwide as a time of fasting, prayer, and reflection. It is a period of spiritual renewal, emphasizing charity and community support. However, for marginalized communities in Pakistan, Ramadan can be particularly challenging as many struggle to afford basic food essentials. Low-income families, daily wage laborers, and those affected by economic instability often face food insecurity, making it difficult to observe fasting with proper nourishment.




Recognizing these challenges, every year, GEESE implements a large-scale Ramadan food distribution initiative to support low-income families. This program provides essential food supplies to underprivileged households, ensuring they have adequate nutrition during the holy month of fasting. By distributing food packs containing staple items such as flour, rice, lentils, sugar, and cooking oil, GEESE helps families observe Ramadan with dignity and without the burden of food scarcity. In 2024, GEESE successfully delivered Ramadan food baskets to 500 families in Dadu, Attock and Mansehra significantly impacting their well-being and spiritual observance.











Qurbani, is a fundamental religious practice in Islam, performed during Eid-ul-Adha to commemorate the willingness of Prophet Ibrahim (AS) to sacrifice his son as an act of obedience to Allah. It is an occasion of deep spiritual significance, promoting charity, gratitude, and the sharing of food with those in need. However, for marginalized communities in Pakistan, affording meat remains a luxury that many cannot afford, making Qurbani a vital source of nutrition for them.

As part of its seasonal support programs, GEESE conducts Qurbani meat distribution every Eid-ul-Adha to ensure that economically disadvantaged families receive fresh and nutritious meat. In 2024, GEESE distributed Qurbani meat packs to 2050 families across multiple districts, including Attock, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Swat, Quetta, Loralai, and Peshawar. Cows, bulls, goats, and sheep were locally sourced from cattle farms and slaughtered at various distribution points in targeted villages.



To maximize outreach, door-to-door distribution was also carried out, ensuring that even the most vulnerable households benefited from this initiative. This program not only provided essential protein intake to underserved communities but also strengthened social solidarity by allowing them to participate in the joy and blessings of Eid.

























In response to the devastating flooding of river Sutluj in 2023 in Pakistan, GEESE launched an emergency relief project for the flood victims in District Okara. This initiative aimed to support affected families by providing supplementary food packs, ensuring they had access to essential nutrition during the crisis. Supplementary food packs typically contain nutrient-rich, non-perishable items such as fortified flour, pulses, rice, sugar, high-energy biscuits, and dry milk, designed to meet immediate dietary needs during emergencies. These packs help prevent malnutrition, boost immunity, and sustain energy levels among displaced populations facing food scarcity.

Additionally, hygiene kits were distributed to promote health and prevent disease outbreaks in disaster-affected communities. In October–November 2023, GEESE successfully provided assistance to 500 families in Okara, Punjab, ensuring their access to both essential nutrition and hygiene support during the crisis.
















IMPACIAND OUTREACH
